"The authority of Scripture means that all the words in Scripture are God's words in such a way that to disbelieve or disobey any word of Scripture is to disbelieve or disobey God." Wayne Grudem

1. The Bible is God's Word.

- Inerrancy: Because God cannot lie, the Bible does not contain any errors.
- Infallibility: Because God will never fail, the Bible will never fail.
- Authority: Because God has final and ultimate authority, the Bible has final and ultimate authority.

2. The Bible commands obedience to God's Word.

3. Because no one else has the same authority as God, nothing else has the same authority as God's Word.

You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the Lord your God that I command you. **Deuteronomy 4:2**

4. The Bible is the final authority in all matters of faith and practice.

"The Bible reveals the principles by which God judges us, and therefore is, and will remain to the end of the world, the true center of Christian union, and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and religious opinions should be tried." Baptist Faith and Message 2000, Article 1, the Scriptures
